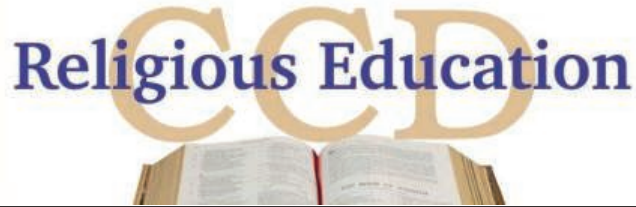

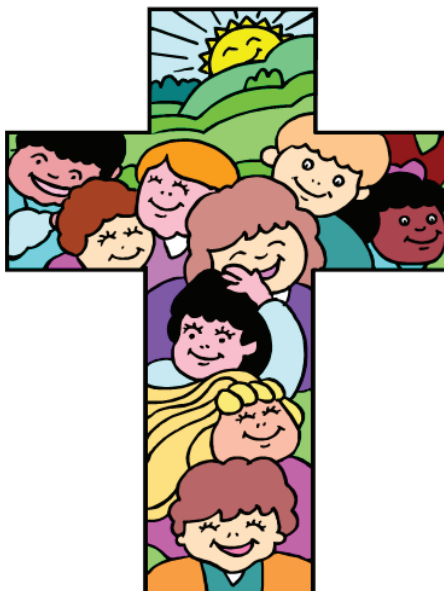
Sacrament of Confirmation

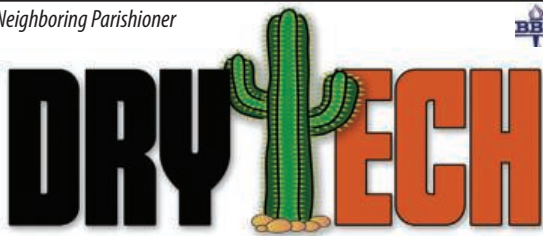
